

BUILDING BACK STRONGER: RAHAT'S KONJYOSOM FLOOD RESPONSE PROJECT

Overview

The Konjyosom Flood Response Project 30.0 was initiated in response to the recent devastating floods and landslides in Nepal, which severely impacted communities in the Kathmandu Valley.

Konjyosom Rural Municipality in Lalitpur was one of the most affected areas, with many families displaced as their homes and belongings were washed away by the Nakkhu (Nallu) River, and access to resources and essential supplies cut off due to blocked roads.



To address these urgent needs, the project provided essential relief items, including food rations and sanitary supplies, to 40 teenage girls across 40 households impacted by the disaster. While this effort was a step toward aiding recovery, it emphasized Rahat's commitment to providing ongoing support and restoring hope to those affected.

Objectives

The primary goal of the project is to test Rahat system and vendor app while supporting the well-being of underprivileged girls.

Specific objectives include:

- Provide immediate relief supplies to the most affected individuals, ensuring basic needs such as food and hygiene are met.
- Use the project as a pilot to test the Rahat platform's Dashboard and Vendor app, which facilitate efficient aid disbursement and management.
- Work alongside local entities, including Konjyosom Rural Municipality and its Ward 5, to enhance the project's reach and ensure effective support for the affected communities.

- **Successful System Testing:** The Rahat vendor app's offline and online functionalities were successfully validated, and the Rahat dashboard proved effective in managing transactions and tracking disbursements.
- **Community Support and Essential Aid:** Provided essential relief aid, including food and sanitary supplies, to 40 households impacted by the flood and landslides.
- **Strengthened Community Collaboration:** Coordinated with local government representatives, ensuring efficient monitoring and smooth distribution of aid.
- **Insights for Improved Aid Delivery and Community Resilience at Rahat:** Gathered insights to strengthen Rahat's future crisis response efforts, aiming to improve aid delivery and community resilience.
